Jesus Knew this was Not Going to Be Easy So He used Symbolism to get His Point Across

- New Wine and Wine Skins
- To us it Means Very Little
- To them it was Rich in Meaning!!!

Change –Actually 3 Parables in 1

The First Parable-

•the old garment speaks of the **legal system or dispensation**, while the new garment **pictures the era of grace**. **They are incompatible**.

"Jesus would do no such thing as tack on Christianity to Judaism. Flesh and law go together, but grace and law, God's righteousness and man's, will never mix."

The Second Parable-

•teaches the folly of putting **new wine into old wineskins**. **Attitude/ Ceremony** - The fermenting action of the new wine causes pressure on the skins which they are no longer pliable or elastic enough to bear. **The skins burst and the wine is spilled**.

The Third Parable-

•Luke adds-He says, "The old is better." This pictures the natural reluctance of men to abandon the old for the new

Jesus Gives a Great Parable About Change

"No one pours new wine into old wineskins"

- The Wine is the Grace of God in the New Covenant
- The Old Wineskins were the Traditions of the Elders
- The New Wine will Burst the Old Wineskins
- Wineskins were Made from Animal Skins

- the neck tied off where the wine has been poured in, the whole large skin bulging almost to bursting as the carbon dioxide gas generated by the fermentation process stretches it to its limit.
- Fermentation in the wineskin might continue for another 2 to 4 months until the process slows down and stops
- By that time the skin has been stretched to its limit

Jesus Gives a Great Parable About Change

Old Wine Skins (attitude of Tradition)

- oEmotions= Numb / Stale
- OMotions = Mechanical / Predictable / Inflexible
- Religion Held Hostage (resists change)

New Wine Skins (attitude of Expectancy)

- oEmotions= Alive / Fresh
- OMotions = Spontaneous / Unpredictable / Flexible
- Gospel Gave Hope (change)

Jesus Gives a Great Parable About Change

Luke adds Jesus saying, "The old is better" (Luke 5:39)

He Meant that Some People are Reluctant to Change

- Stuck in the Past and Like It
- Stay with What they are Accustomed To
- They Don't Try the New Wine
- They Fail to Give the New Wine a Chance

The Truth is that Over Time, as the New Wine Seasons...
...it will Become the Best Wine of All

The Elements of Change

Change Occurs when Three Things are Present

- **1- Pain** a discomfort with the way things are
- 2- Hope a vision of the ways things could be -Jer 29:11; John 4:34
- 3- **Strategy** a plan of the steps to take us where we want to go

The Expressions of Change

Change Comes in Two Forms:

- •Fix Something Broken (Remedial)
 - ofocuses on problem solving
- Grow in New Ways (Developmental)goal directed
- Change for Change Sake is Pointless
- •It's just Rearranging the Deck Furniture on the Titanic
- •Outcome based thinking. What is the goal? What do you expect to achieve? What is the product?



The Emotions of Change

Change Can Be Met with Two Feelings:

- **1- Fear** (Num 13:31-33).
 - Fear Makes us Resist Change
 - Change is Unpredictable so we Tend to...Stay With What We Know
- 2- Faith (Num 14:8-9, 24)
 - Faith makes us Embrace Change and
 - See Things the Way They Can Be
