

What Joshua Needed was a Dose of God-Inspired Confidence.

- •Confidence is Simply a Feeling Of Trust, Reliance, Faith, and Certainty in Someone or Something.
- •Not Self-confidence but Christ-Confidence.
- •Joshua's name was really a new name given to him by Moses.
- •His original name was *Hoshea* (Numbers 13:8), meaning *"salvation"*
- •Joshua means "The Lord is salvation" with emphasis on the Lord.
- •Joshua was indeed the Instrument God Used...
 - ...but the Lord himself was the Source of
- Victory.

Notice How Often Scripture Exhorts us to Confident Living:

•Proverbs 3:26: "For the Lord will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being snared."

•Jeremiah 17:5, 7: "This is what the Lord says: 'Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who depends on flesh for his strength and whose heart turns away from the Lord... But blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him."

•Philippians 1:6: "Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion."

•Hebrews 10:35: "Do not throw away your confidence."

•Hebrews 13:6: "So we say with confidence..."

•1 John 4:17: 'We will have confidence on the day of judgment."

Three Promises From God... ...When You Need the Confidence ...to Go On and ...Assures Powe Perspective

Divine Promise... *I Will Give You Every Place You Set Your Foot* (3, 4)

Divine Promise + Human Responsibility = Success.

- · God Gave the land, but the People had to Possess It.
- By faith, we Claim the Promises of God.
- We have to "set our foot" on the Promise for it to be a Reality.
- · God looks for Active Faith, not Passive Faith.

The Warrior Spirit

•We need the **Spirit** of **Joshua** and **Caleb**, who were Willing to Possess the Promised Land- Num 14:6-9

Divine Power...

•Why? Because He was Doing the Will of God.

...Will of God Herein Lies Our Confidence

Deuteronomy 28:2 (KJV)

² And all these blessings shall come on thee, and <u>overtake</u> thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

⁷ The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

Divine Power...

I Will Be With You as I Was With Moses (5)

God was with Moses in...

- Providential Care: Protected from harm while confronting Pharaoh
- Limitless Sufficiency: On Mount Sinai he meets God as the great "I Am," meaning, I will be what you need in every situation.
- Divine Authority: God transformed his shepherd's rod into a sign of authority
- **Miracle Power**. Through the power of God, the destroyer of the firstborn smote Egypt, the sea parted, manna came from heaven, water issued forth from the rock, the cloud guided them through the desert, they were victorious in battle
- Close Friendship: God spoke with Moses face-to-face
