

- React- "Say Complain"
 - The Pressure has Built Up...
 - ... Have to Release!
- Reason-"my way Hidden from Lord"
 - o He Can't Even See This- Its Beyond Him
 - o Satan has Powerful Advantage
- Resolve-"my Cause Disregarded fr my God"
 - o If He Does See It...He Doesn't Care
 - o He Has Just Thrown It/ Me to Side

 - o can't get Enough Distance between...
 ...You and Problem
- Deny
 - Avoiding the Problem only...
 ...Gives the Problem More Power
- Give Up
 - o All your Fight is Gone ...Loose Appetite for Victory

 - o Danger- Trust in Own Strength
 - o None of Us can Do It Alone
- (31)- "hope in Lord..renew strength.."
 - o In Troubles Times Remember...
 - ...God Will Not Leave You
 - ...He Doesn't Grow Tired of You
