How God Raises Us to a New Level- Psalm 103: 1–5 The Benefits of Trusting the Lord Listed in this Text Correspond to the Stages God Uses in Building Someone into a Healthy, Spiritual Person. The Psalmist Lists the Benefits In this Order:

- 1. God Pardons (3)— We Must Put Our Past Shame or Blame Behind Us.
- 2. God <u>Heals</u> (3)— We Must Become <u>Healthy</u> and Be <u>Liberated</u> from Old <u>Wounds</u>.
- 3. God <u>Redeems</u> (4)— We Can <u>See</u> Our <u>Abilities</u> and <u>Personality</u> Redeemed.

4. God Crowns (4)— We Are Crowned with Gifts and a Place to Serve.

5. God Satisfies (5)— We Feel Satisfied and Fulfilled as We Live Out Our Purpose.
