- During these moments, God has things that He wants to say specifically for you. In turn, you must make yourself ready/willing to receive/accept instructions.

Your <u>Future</u>

If you've endured a life-altering disappointment, you may have good reason to ask, "where do I go from here, Lord?" In time, He will answer you. His answer may not come immediately, and it may not come in a way that you expect. But He will answer -Matt 7:7, 8
