

The Power of Reproduction

- **1 Kernel of Corn Will Produce 1 Corn Stalk.**
- **On The Average, Each Stalk will Produce 3 Ears.**
- **The Average Ear of Corn has 250 Kernels**

So that a Single Kernel of Corn ...

...will Yield a 750 Kernals

... 75,000 % Increase.

This Deals With Personal:

- **Responsibility** –*quit looking to blame*
- **Faithfulness** –*start planting –quit talking*
- **Faith** –*it is possible to limit our harvest*
