

Due Season



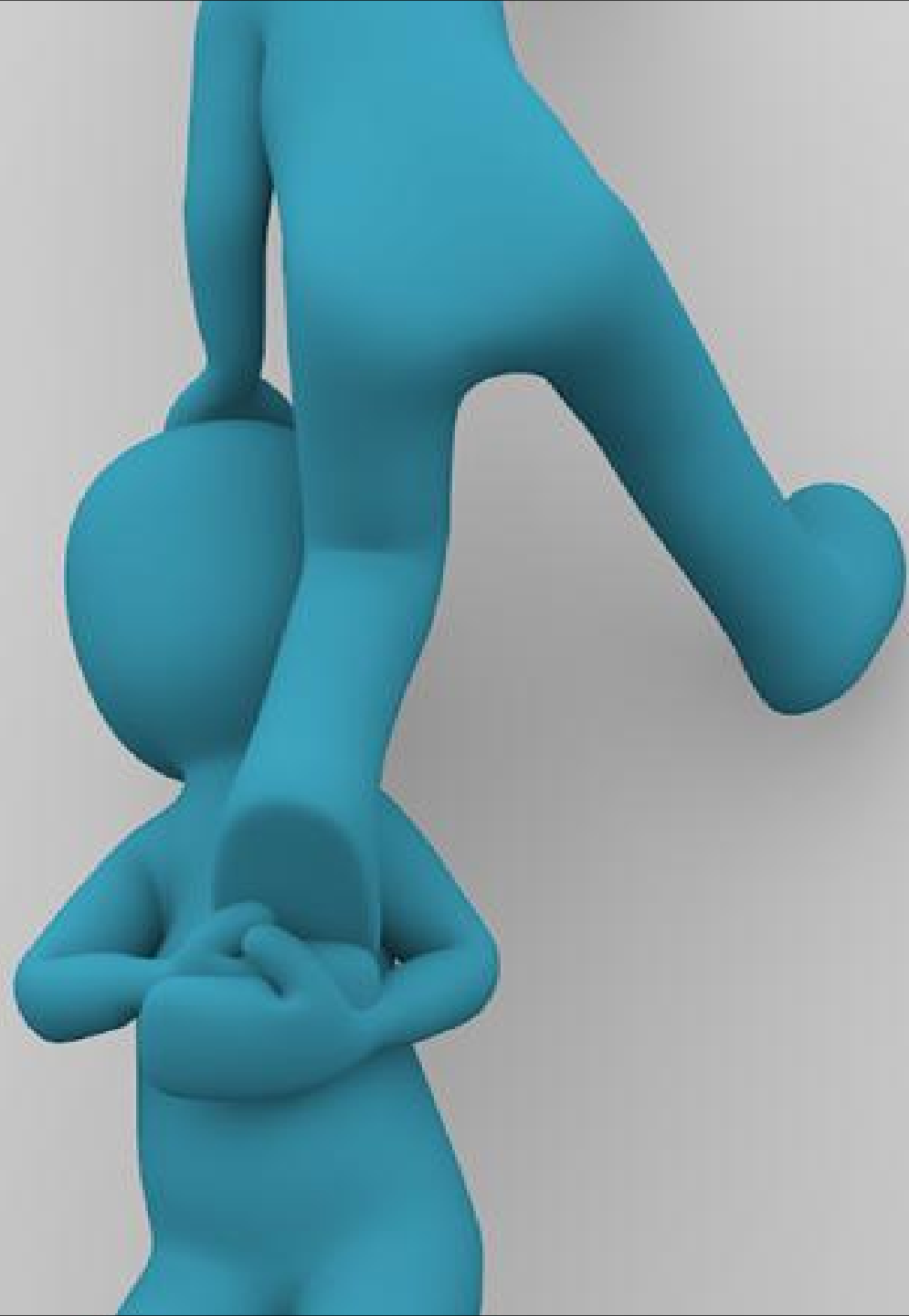
We Reap in a Different Season than” “”

(*convenient, due*) season, (*due, short*) time**

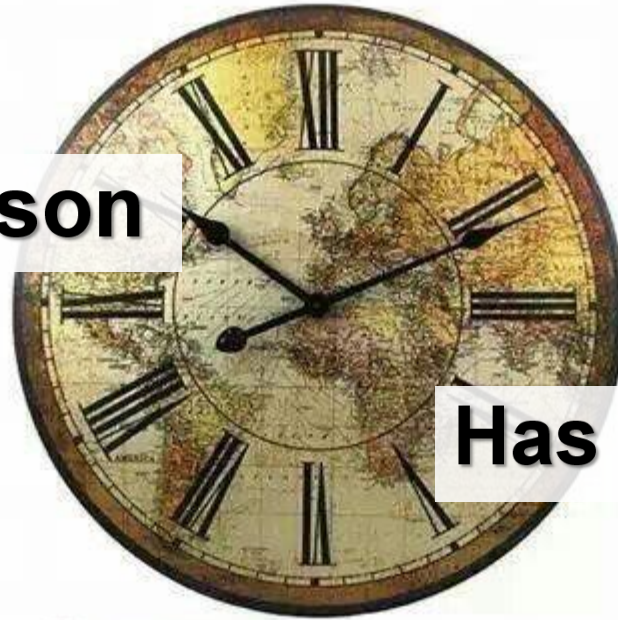
