Six Different Kinds of Listeners.

PREOCCUPIEDS

- These people come across as rushed, constantly looking around or doing something else.



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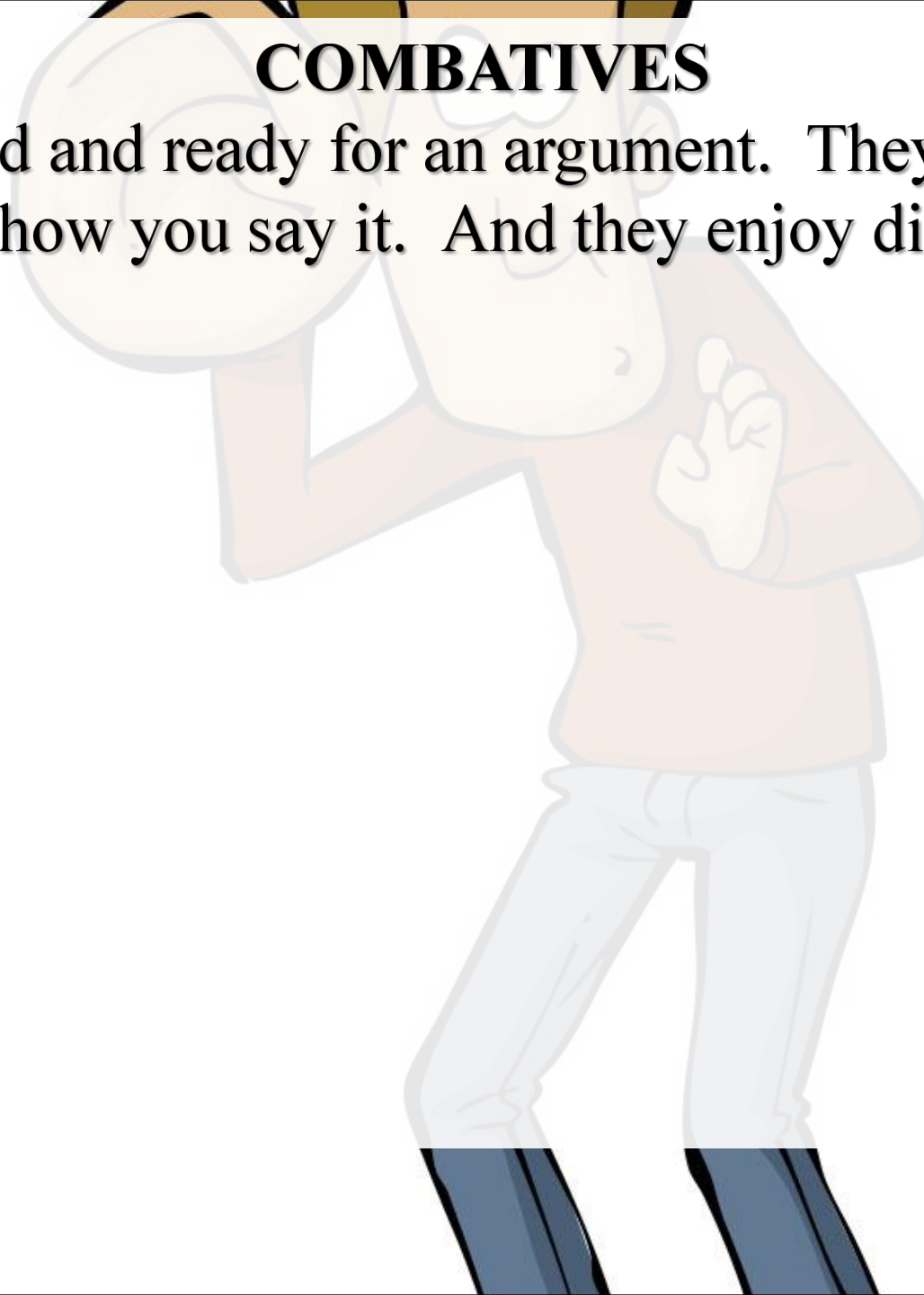
WHATEVERS

- These people remain aloof, and show little reaction when listening. They don't seem to care about anything you have to say.



COMBATIVES

- These people are armed and ready for an argument. They listen only to find the flaw in what you say or how you say it. And they enjoy disagreeing with whatever is said.

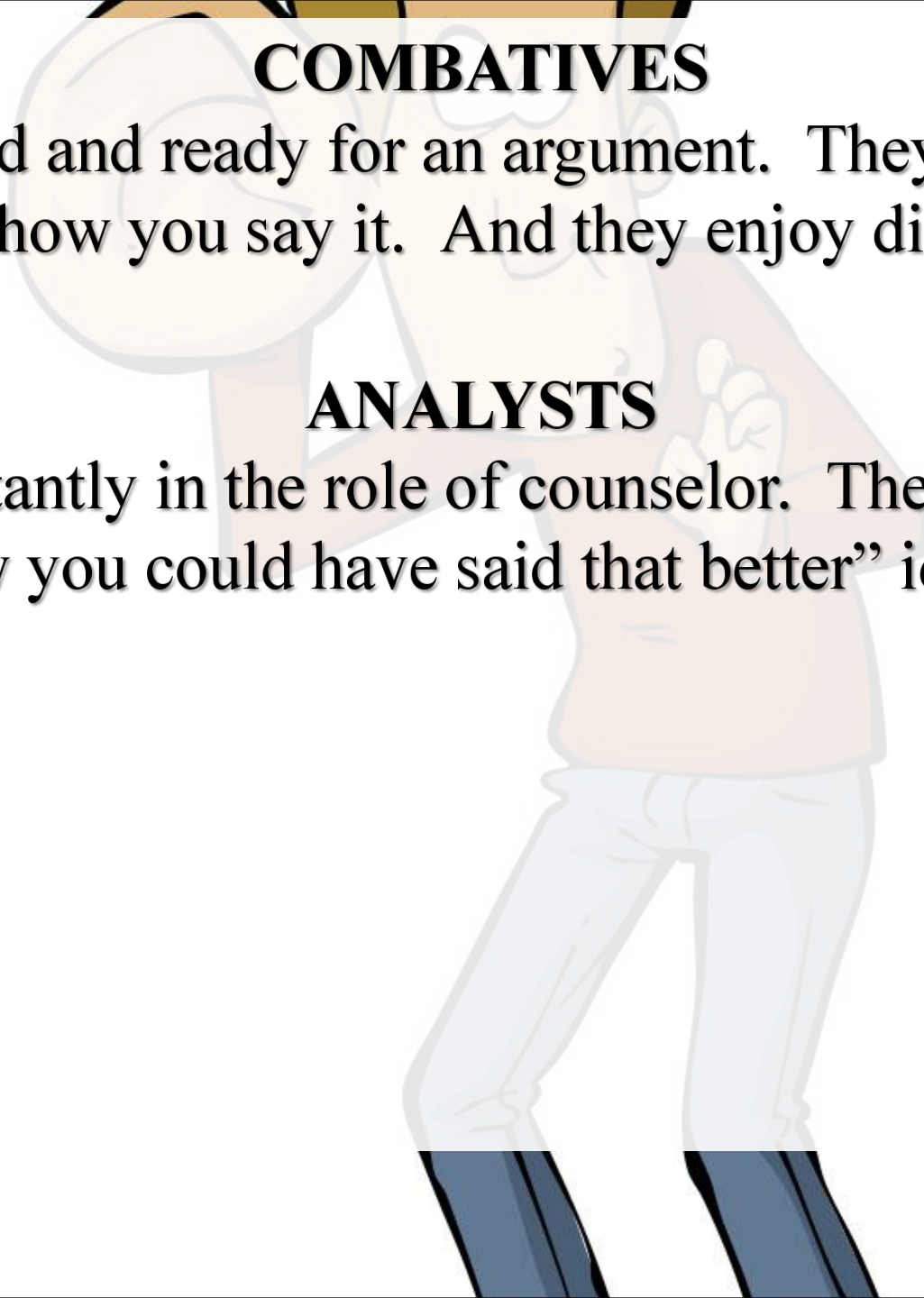


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The First 5 Types of Listeners are Usually:

**Listen to Understand.

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- True, sustained, Active Listening is a Great Act of Faith, and a Great means of Grace, Both for ourselves and for others in the Fellowship.

- James 1:19: "Let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger."
- It's simple Enough In Principle, and Nearly Impossible to Live.

Seven Don'ts for Successful Listen

#1 Don't Feel You Must Do the Talking

"[There is] a time to tear/ a time to mend, a time to be silent / a time to speak." -Ecc 3:7

#2 Don't Give Premature Advice

"He who answers before listening—that is his folly and his shame." -Prov 18:13

#3 Don't Become Defensive

"A man's wisdom gives him patience; it is to his glory to overlook an offense." -Prov 19:11

#4 Don't Become Hot-Tempered

"A hot-tempered man stirs up dissension, but a patient man calms a quarrel." -Prov 15:18

#5 Don't Laugh At Others

"A man who lacks judgment derides his neighbor, but a man of understanding holds his tongue." -Prov 11:12

#6 Don't Hold On To Hatred.

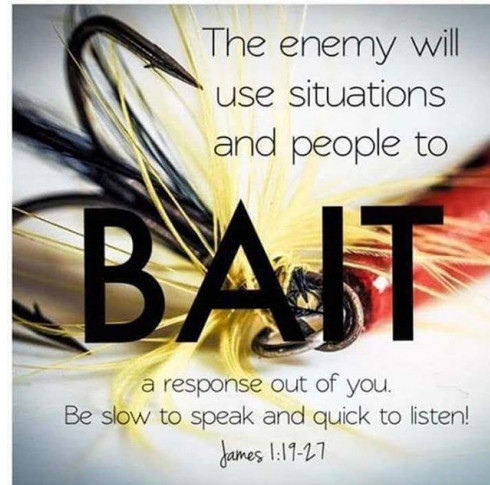
"Hatred stirs up dissension, but love covers over all wrongs." -Prov 10:12

"A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy man keeps a secret." -Prov 11:13

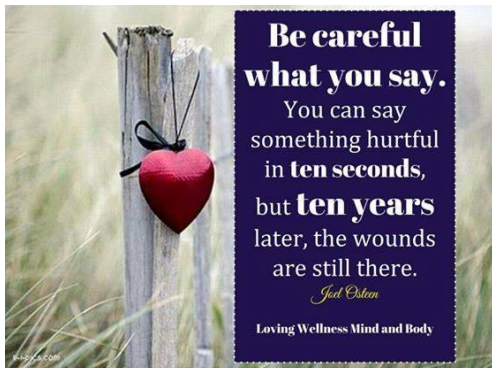
