Seven Days to Claiming Your Identity in Christ

In order for Christians to **walk in victory**, we need to **identify** the lies we **believe** about **ourselves**/ **exchange** them for the **truth** about who we really are in Christ. The following are seven **lies** we tell ourselves followed by seven **truths** from **God's Word**. For lasting **change**, we must cast aside the lies /rely on **Gods' Truth**. "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." -

Romans 12:2

Look at one of the lies each day. Ask yourself, *Am I believing this lie?* Then look up Scriptures for that day and write them down. Read them aloud, and thank God that His Word confirms the truth about you— *whether you feel like it or not.* If you repeat this each time, you will begin to see yourself through God's eyes.

Day One... My New Family

• Lie:

"I can't feel valuable unless I'm loved and accepted by my family and the significant people in my life."

• Truth:

I have God-given value because I have been placed into a <u>new family</u> where I am <u>unconditionally</u> loved and <u>accepted</u> by God.

- I am <u>Chosen</u> by God- "*He chose* us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight." -Eph 1:4
- I am <u>Adopted</u> by God-"In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will." -Eph 1:4-5
- I am a <u>Child</u> of God.- "To all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." -John 1:12
- I am Born <u>Again</u>.- "You have been born again, not of perishable seed, but..imperishable. through the living/ enduring word of God." -1 Peter 1:23

Day Two... My New Characteristics

• Lie:

"I'll never feel valuable because this is just the way I am. I cannot change."

• Truth:

I have God-given value because God has changed me on the inside -given me new characteristics.

• I am a New Creation

"If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" -2 Cor 5:17

• I have a New <u>Nature</u>

"In him you were also circumcised, in the **putting off of the sinful nature**, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ." -Col 2:11

• I have a New <u>Heart</u>

"I will give you a new heart/..new spirit in you; ..remove..heart of stone/ ..heart of flesh." -Ezk 36:26

• I have a New Spirit

"I will put my Spirit in you/ move you to follow my decrees/ be careful to keep my laws." -Ezk 36:27

• I have a New Mind

Day Three... My New Clothing

• Lie:

"I can't feel I have value unless I live in the right neighborhood, w- the right car / the right clothes." • Truth:

I have God-given value because I have a new residence in God's kingdom /new clothing of Christ

- I am <u>Clothed</u> with Christ. "All of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ." -Gal 3:27
- I am <u>Baptized</u> into Christ.

"We were therefore buried with him through **baptism** into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." **-Ro 6:4**

- I am <u>Hidden</u> in Christ. "For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God." -Col 3:3
- I am <u>Sealed</u> with the Spirit of Christ.

"You also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with **a seal**, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory." -Ephesians 1:13-14

• Truth:

I have God-Given Value, for I've been given a new life in Jesus Christ.

• I am <u>Redeemed</u>. -bought back

"In him we have **redemption** through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace." -Eph 1:7

• I am <u>Washed</u>. -cleaned up

"That is what some of you were [wicked]. But you were **washed**, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God." -1 Cor 6:11

- I am <u>Purified</u>. -propped up "If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellow ship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin." -1 John 1:7
- I am <u>Justified</u>. -face up "Since we.. been justified through faith, we have peace w- God through our Lord Jesus Christ." -Ro 5:1
- I am <u>Sanctified</u>. -washed up "You were washed.sanctified,.. justified ..name of the Lord Jesus Christ/ Spirit of our God." -1 Cor 6:11

• Lie:

"My life has value as long as I can look good to others."

• Truth:

I have God-given value even though I have fallen in the past and may stumble in the future. He has given me a new image.

Remember- God Doesn't Do Anything "Halfway"

• I Am Totally <u>Accepted</u> by Christ. "Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God." -Romans 15:7

- I am Totally <u>Blameless</u> Before Christ. "He has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation." -Colossians 1:22
- I Am Totally <u>Righteous</u> in Christ. "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the **righteousness of** God." -2 Corinthians 5:21
- I Am Totally <u>Complete</u> in Christ. "In Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and you have been given fullness [made complete] in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority." -Colossians 2:9-10
- I Am Totally Perfect Because of Christ. "By one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy." -Hebrews 10:14

Day Six... My New Freedom

• Lie:

"My life has no value because I have failed and deserve to be punished."

• Truth:

I have God-given value **based not** on my **past performance** but on **Christ**, who lives **in me** and who **gives me freedom** from condemnation.

• I Am Free from <u>Accusation</u>.

"He has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and *free from accusation*." -Colossians 1:22

• I Am Free from <u>Condemnation</u>. "Therefore, there is now **no condemnation** for those who are in Christ Jesus." -Romans 8:1

• I Am Free from the <u>Law</u>.

"So, my brothers, you also **died to the law** through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit to God." **-Romans 7:4**

• I Am Free from Sin. "In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus." -Romans 6:11

• I Am Free from <u>God's Wrath</u>.

"Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!" -Romans 5:9

Day Seven... My New Inheritance

• Lie:

"My life has no value if I do not succeed financially and leave a comfortable inheritance."

• Truth:

I have <u>God-Given Value</u> because I've been given a <u>new inheritance</u> that provides the only <u>true</u> and <u>lasting</u> <u>significance</u> and <u>security</u> possible.

- I Have Been Made an Heir of God. "So you are no longer a slave, but a son;/ since you are a son, God has made you.. an heir." -Gal 4:7
- I Have Inherited Everything Needed to be Godly.

"His divine power has given us everything we need for life and **godliness** through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness." -2 Peter 1:3

• I Have Inherited a Divine Nature.

"Through these he has given us his very great /precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the *divine nature*/ escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires."-2 Pet 1:4

• I Have Inherited Every Spiritual Blessing.

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ." -Ephesians 1:3

• I Have Inherited Eternal Life.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have *eternal life*." -John 3:16 _____
