This Story deals with Many Issues Misplaced...

- Attitudes
 - How Do You Perceive God's Deposit in You
 - Ownership vs Stewardship
- Actions
 - How Do You Handle God's Deposit in You
 - Please Self vs Please Father
- Associations
 - Healthy vs Unhealthy

Greatest Example of Wasted Stewardship

The Prodigal

He Had...

- Power
 - Associated "Family Power"
 - Personal Power -did what he wanted w-limits
- Protection
 - His Father
 - His Family
- Potential
 - Unlimited
 - Conditional

The Set Up

This Young Man was in a

- Awesome Place ...but Couldn't See It
 - So It Became a...
 - Neglected Place
 - Forfeited Place
 - Longed for Place

The Son Grew Complacent with...

...the Father's Thing (11-12)

He had a Change in Attitude

- ☐ He Could Not Wait to Do Things
 - Under the Proper Conditions
 - In the Proper Way
 - Without His Father's Leadership
 - From Stewardship to Ownership

"Leave God's Word and Purpose"

The Son Decided to Do...

...His Own Thing (13)

- He had a Change in Actions
 - ☐ He Gathered All Together
 - ☐ He Journeyed to Far Country
 - Got as Far Away as Possible
 - From Father's Authority, Influence

"Leave God's House"

The Son Realized His Thing...

...was not Just His Thing (13b)

He had a Change in Association

- Wasted (scattered)
- Riotous (wasteful -living -associations)
 - He is now the "life of the party"
 - He lives with "no limits"
 - He lives with "no responsibility"
 - Soon He will live with "no help!"

"Wasted Stewardship"

The Son was Forced to Do...

...Someone Else's Thing (14-16)

He had a Change in Authority

- He was Unprepared
 - to Handle the Change; "spent all"
 - Without "Famine"
 - Within "be in Want"
- He was Unable to Sustain
 - Had to Join to Citizen
 - Join (enter into covenant; glue to)


"From Ownership to Spiritual Poverty"

The Son Realized that He Needed...

...the Father's Thing (17-20a)

He had a Change in Attitude -3 parts

- ☐ He "came to himself"
 - Deals w- His Attitude
- ☐ He said "I will arise..."
 - Deals w- His Decisions
- ☐ He "arose / came..."
 - Deals w- His Actions

Needed a...

- New Start
- New Perspective
- New Song

The Father had a...

...Releasing Love (12-13)

- He Realized that His Son had...
 - ...Lost Reality
- ☐ He Realized that He had to Allow Him to...
 - ...Discover What was Real
- He had to Trust God and Circumstances
 - ...to Send Him Back

"God will not Force Stewardship"

The Father had a...

...Restoring Love (20b-21)


- Saw afar off -he never stopped looking
- Compassion -bowels yearn -strongest word
- Ran
 - Law considered him dead
 - Law allowed stoning –had to hit Dad 1st
- Fell -to seize, embrace
- Kissed –present tense; kept on kissing
- "When you take the 1st Step Toward Him..."

The Father had a...

...Restoring Love (22)

- □ Robe represents Purity
 - Cover the Stains /Scars of the Far Country
 - Represents Son-ship / Honor
- □ Ring represents Privilege
 - Moved to Position of Authority
- □ Shoes represents Position
 - Elevated Above Servant to Son


"God will Restore..."
