PROBLEM: Your sense of right and wrong can slowly change **overtime**. Social **standards** change as cultures change.

• Hope in Legal Justice

- Hope in People's Promises
- PROBLEM: Your faith can be fractured when people break their promises. People you look up to can let you down.
- Hope in an Organization's Integrity/ Tightness **PROBLEM:** Your faith in any organization (even a church or ministry) can be destroyed as a result of unrighteous behavior—not doing what is right in God's sight—a lack of integrity.
- Hope in your education for Wisdom/Understanding PROBLEM: Your education and the educational system do not guarantee wisdom and understanding. Wisdom is knowing how to apply your knowledge with godly insight.
- Hope in Your Physical Abilities
