Reflect on the Four Ways by Which God Reveals Himself

If God truly is **knowable**—and **He is**—the **question** we need to ask is, "How can we come to Him?" God has **revealed** facts about **Himself** / His **nature** in different **ways** so that we can **know** Him. What are these ways?

Through Christ

"In the beginning was the Word [Christ Jesus], and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life, and that life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it. There came a man who was sent from God; his name was John.
