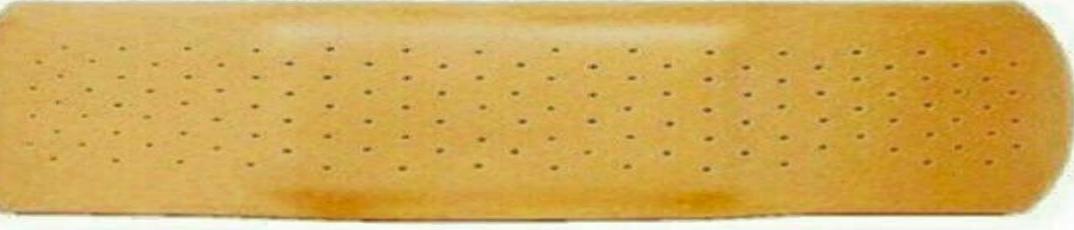

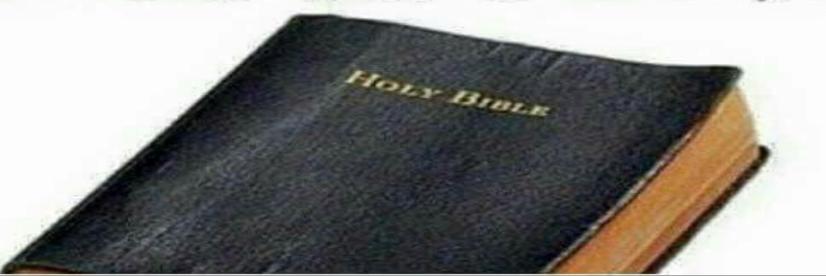

How to Deal with Anger God's Way

So, you have anger issues, how do you deal with it God's way?

Restrain It

Proverbs 29:11, "Fools vent their anger, but the wise quietly hold it back."

- This does not mean that the wise bury their anger or do not deal with it, but...
 - ...it means that they control their anger and how they express it.
- When you Restrain your Anger, you <u>Keep It Within Limits</u>.

· When you restrain your anger, you keep it within limits.

Re-evaluate It

James 1:19-20, "My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires."

God's way of dealing with anger is to be slow to anger.

There are some things that you need to let roll off of your shoulders and not internalize or act on.

When you re-evaluate a person's words or action, you often find there's no need to get angry as that person really did not intend to hurt you or was merely acting out of their own biases, which is not a reflection of you.

How to Deal with Anger God's Way

Restrain It

When you restrain your anger, you keep it within limits.

Re-evaluate It

Let It roll off of your shoulders/ not internalize or act on.

Release It

Colossians 3:8, "But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips."
