Revelation chapter six is a...

...Shock to the Senses.

In the past two chapters, we have been allowed to witness scenes of Heavenly Worship.

In this passage, we are going to see images of Divine Wrath.

Daniel 9: 24-27

- 23 At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to shew [thee]; for thou [art] greatly beloved; therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision.
- 24 **Seventy weeks** are determined **upon thy people and upon thy holy city**, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.
- 25 Know therefore and understand, [that] **from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince [shall be] seven weeks**, and **threescore and two weeks**: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.
- 26 And after **threescore and two weeks** shall **Messiah be cut off**, but not for himself: and the people of **the prince that shall come** shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.
- 27 And **he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week**: and **in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease**, and for **the overspreading of abominations he shall make [it] desolate**, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

Reason for the Tribulation Period

Daniel 9:24

- 24 **Seventy weeks** are determined **upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to**
 - **Finish transgression**
- 25 Know therefore and understand, [that] from the going forth of the **commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince**
 - **Put an end to sin**
- 26 And after **the Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city**
 - **Atone for wickedness**
 - **Bring everlasting righteousness**
- 27 And he **shall seal up the vision and prophecy**
 - **Seal up vision and prophecy**
 - **Anoint the Most Holy**
