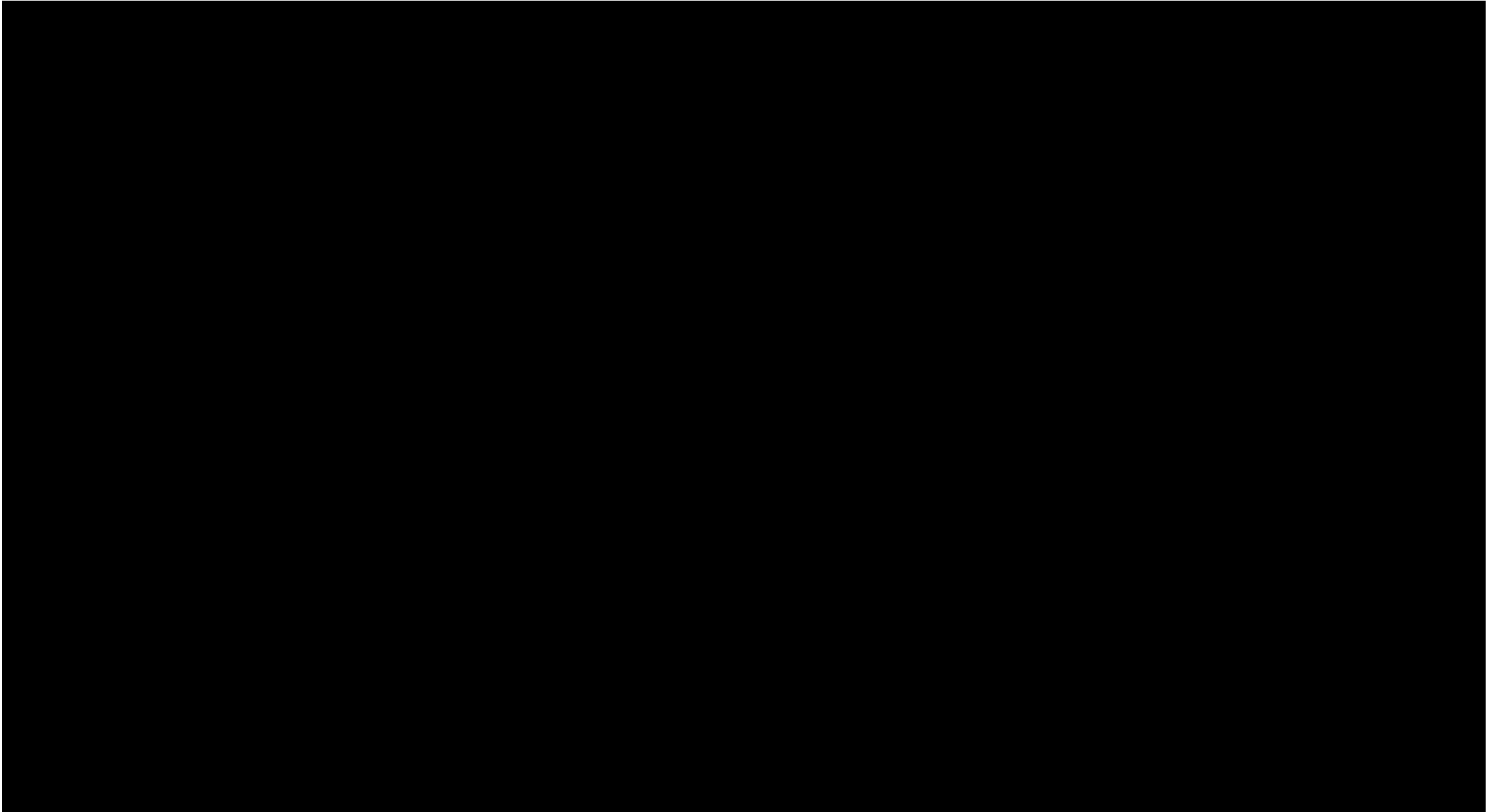

**One of the Most Misunderstood Scriptures
Judge Has Multiple Meanings in Greek**

- **Condemn – NO**
- **You Become Judge and Jury – Pass Sentence**
 - **Discern – YES**
- **You See Situations and Understand**

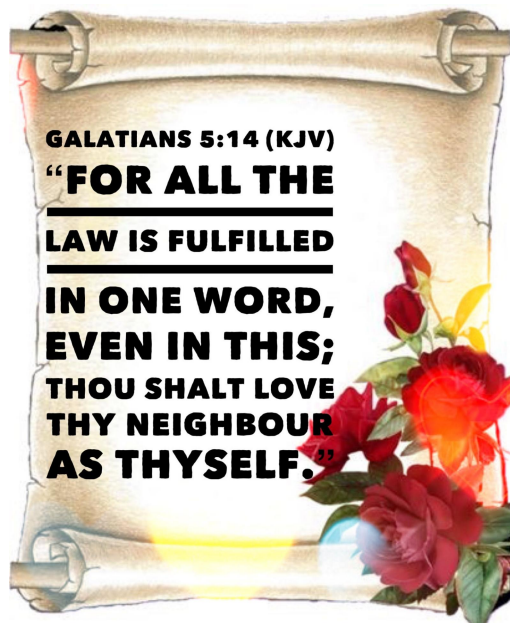

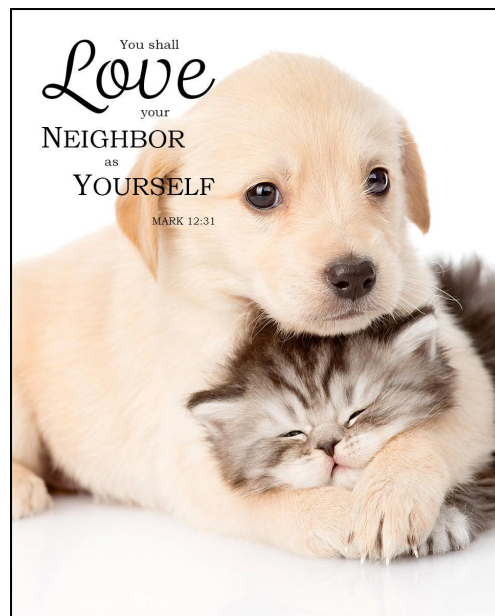
Matthew 7:1-5 (AMP)

- ¹ DO NOT judge *and* criticize *and* condemn others, so that you may not be judged *and* criticized *and* condemned yourselves. ² For just as you judge *and* criticize *and* condemn others, you will be judged *and* criticized *and* condemned, and in accordance with the measure you [use to] deal out to others, it will be dealt out again to you. ³ Why do you stare from without at the very small particle that is in your brother's eye but do not become aware of *and* consider the beam of timber that is in your own eye?
- ⁴ Or how can you say to your brother, Let me get the tiny particle out of your eye, when there is the beam of timber in your own eye?
- ⁵ You hypocrite, first get the beam of timber out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the tiny particle out of your brother's eye.

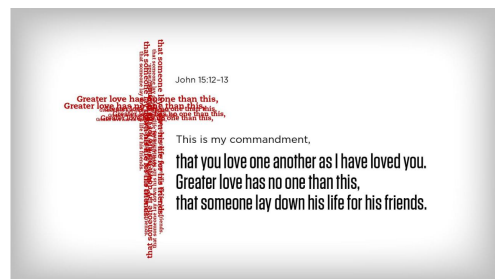

- ***Don't talk to others about their faults while you ignore your own faults.***

"How can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?" (4)

- ***Don't be hypocritical -correct your faults before correcting someone else's !***

"You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye." (5)
