

Deuteronomy 25:5-6 (KJV)

- 5 If brethren dwell together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead shall not marry without unto a stranger: her husband's brother shall go in unto her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother unto her.
- 6 And it shall be, that the firstborn which she beareth shall succeed in the name of his brother which is dead, that his name be not put out of Israel.

Jesus is Our Kinsman Redeemer

He Must Be Near Of Kin (Position) Jesus Became Like Us

"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth" - **John 1:14**

Hebrews 2:17 (AMP)

¹⁷ So it is evident that it was essential that He be made like His brethren in every respect, in order that He might become a merciful (sympathetic) / faithful High Priest in the things related to God, to make atonement / propitiation for the people's sins.



He Must Be Able To Redeem (Possession) Jesus Was Able to Redeem

Hebrews 9:12 (AMP)

He went once for all into the [Holy of] Holies [of heaven], not by virtue of the blood of goats and calves [by which to make reconciliation between God and man], but His own blood, having found and secured a complete redemption (an everlasting release for us).



The Power of a Kinsman Redeemer

He Must Be Willing to Redeem (Passion) Jesus Was Willing to Do It

Philippians 2:5-8 (NLT2)

⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave/ was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, ⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.

Jesus Paid the Complete Price for Our Sin


John 19:30 (KJV)
