She Passed The Test Of Rejection (24)

- Did You Know There Are Great Heroes In The Bible That Did Too?
- Rejection Can Actually Be A Manifestation Of God's Love.

- They All Felt God's Rejection, Sought God And Found His Favor.

She Passed the Test of Humility (26)

- She Was At The Mercy Of God.
- She Had No Leverage; No Bargaining Chips...
 - ...Nothing To "Wow" God With Or Offer In Exchange.
- Such A Place Makes Us Feel Vulnerable Even Out Of Control
 ...But When Standing Before God, It Is A Safe Place
