A 9ift that's meant to be cherished, nurtured, and shared



What Does This Tell us about The Gift of Joy?

- JOY IS ESSENTIAL FOR OUR WELL-being.
- · It's NOT a LUXURY, NOT an OPTIONAL EXTRA, BUT A NECESSITY
- Without Joy, our spirit is crushed, our life force is Drained, our Bones are Dried up
- With Joy, Our Spirit Is Uplifted, Our Life force Is Renewed, Our Bones Are Strengthened

What Does This Tell Us About The Gift Of Joy? It Tells Us That Joy Is Not Dependent On Circumstances

- It's Not Contingent On What's Happening Around Us
- It's Not Determined By The Ups And Downs Of Life
- It's Dependent On Our Relationship With God
- It's Determined By Our Trust In His Promises

 - · Complete Joy
 - · Overflowing Joy


- It's a call to action, not a passive observation
- Paul is telling us to rejoice, to celebrate, to be joyful (X2)


The Command to Rejoice is Not Conditional

- NOT, "Rejoice if you feel like it, or things are going well"
- · He simply says, "Rejoice in the Lord always
- This is a call to constant, unceasing, unwavering joy
- It's a call to celebrate, regardless of circumstances, feelings
- Its a profound challenge, but also a profound opportunity


This is a testament to Paul's unwavering faith, his unshakeable trust in God, his unyielding commitment to the gospel.
