

Now the Philistines gathered their armies together to battle, and were gathered at Sochoh, which belongs to Judah; they encamped between Sochoh and Azekah, in Ephes Dammim. ²And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and they encamped in the Valley of Elah, and drew up in battle array against the Philistines. ³The Philistines stood on a mountain on one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side, with a valley between them.

⁴And a champion went out from the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, from Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span. 5 He had a bronze helmet on his head, and he was armed with a coat of mail, and the weight of the coat was five thousand shekels of bronze. 6 And he had bronze armor on his legs and a bronze javelin between his shoulders. 7 Now the staff of his spear was like a weaver's beam, and his iron spearhead weighed six hundred shekels; and a shield-bearer went before him. 8 Then he stood and cried out to the armies of Israel, and said to them, "Why have you come out to line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and you the servants of Saul? Choose a man for yourselves, and let him come down to me. 9 If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us." 10 And the Philistine said, "I defy the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together." 11 When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were dismayed and greatly afraid.



A biant is Anything that... ...Intimidates with it's size ... Threatens with it's Power ... seeks to take Away stands between You and victory



I Samuel 17:10-11

And the Philistine said, I **defy** the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together. When Saul and all Israel heard those words of the Philistine, they were **dismayed**, and greatly **afraid**.

- Defy- to pull off, to expose by stripping away
- **Dismayed-** to *break* down, by violence or confusion and fear, beat down, discourage –**Shut Down With-out**
- Greatly- vehement- to farthest/ smallest part
- Afraid- dread, fear -alarm, Intimidate -Shut Down With-In

Israel was Shut Down!



"Giants Come to Put Us in Fear"

- David and Goliath, was a Literal Giant...
 ...a towering figure of intimidation and fear.
- Goliath, a seasoned warrior, was a physical manifestation...
 ... of the fear that can grip us in our lives.
- Giants we face today may not be physical; they can be ...situations, circumstances, or struggles that seem ...insurmountable and cause us to tremble in fear
- These giants can take the form of financial difficulties, health issues, relationship problems, or even spiritual battles
- They loom large in our lives...
 ...casting a shadow of fear and doubt

Giants Come to Put Us in Fear "Fear is a Powerful Emotion"

It can paralyze us, preventing us from moving forward.

It can cloud our judgment, causing us to make poor decisions.

It can even cause us to question our faith…
…leading us to wonder if God is really there for us.

We may feel small, insignificant, and powerless, ... just as the Israelites must have felt in the presence of Goliath.



"Fear is a Powerful Emotion"

- · The Israelites were terrified of boliath.
- · They saw his size, strength, weapons, they were filled with fear.
- · They focused on the giant before them rather than on their God.
- · They allowed their fear of boliath to overshadow their faith in bod.
 - · This is a common response when we face giants in our lives.
 - We focus on the size of our problem rather than on the size of our
 - tod. We allow our fear to dictate our actions rather than allowing our faith to guide us.





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"fear is a natural Response to the biants in our Lives" it's a reaction to the unknown, uncertain, overwhelming. But we must not let fear control us.

There is no **fear** in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment.

- Fear-phobia -Unrealistic alarm or fright: fear, terror.
- Love (agapao); Divine love, i.e. affection or benevolence;
- Perfect (telos); complete (labor, growth, mental and moral
 - Casteth plucked off- cast out, thrown away, unattached
 - Torment penal infliction :- punishment, torment.
- God's Freedom is Greater than Our Fear!!

PRAISES WITH understanding.

Faith is not a magical shield that makes our problems disappear.

It is a deep trust in God that gives us the courage to face our problems, knowing that He is with us and He will help us.
