



David said, May You be praised, LORD God of our father Israel, from eternity to eternity. 11 Yours, LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the splendor and the majesty, for everything in the heavens and on earth belongs to You. Yours, LORD, is the kingdom, and You are exalted as head over all. ¹² Riches and honor come from You, and You are the ruler of everything. Power and might are in Your hand, and it is in Your hand to make great and to give strength to all. 13 Now therefore, our God, we give You thanks and praise Your glorious name. 14 But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? EVERYTHING

Names of God El Shaddai

(pronounced el shad-di')

Meaning: All-Sufficient One. Lord God Almighty.

El is another name that is translated as "God." Shaddai is believed to be derived from the Hebrew word "shad," meaning "breast." This gives the idea that God is completely nourishing, satisfying, and supplying His people with all their needs as a mother would her child. He freely gives nourishment and blessing. He is our sustainer.

Where is it used in the Bible? Genesis 17:1. And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

"Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven." Psalm 148:13



Matthew 6:19-21 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.
