- the Blueprint for a Life Lived in the Fullness of Christ Jesus.



Thankfulness is a Virtue:

- It's not optional for us as followers of Christ.
 - It's something expected / required of us.
- · It's a mark of spiritual maturity, a sign of godly character.
 - It's a fruit of the Spirit, a reflection of the divine nature.
 - It's a testament to our faith, a witness to our hope.

Thankfulness is a Blessing:

- It's not something that's burdensome but beneficial
 - It's a source of joy, peace.
- It's a gateway to contentment, a pathway to fulfillment.
 - It's a gift from God, a treasure from heaven.

I CAME NAKED FROM MY MOTHER'S WOMB. AND I WILL BE NAKED WHENTERAUE THE LORD GAVE ME WHAT I HAD. AND THE LORD HAS TAKEN IT AWAY. PRAISE THE NAME OF THE LORD!"



Job:

- He had everything wealth, family, health/ deep reverence for God
- His wealth was plundered, his children were killed, his health gone
 - Yet, in midst of suffering, his response was one of thankfulness.

"Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised."

-Job 1:21

Job's thankfulness was not tied to his circumstances...
 ...but to his understanding of God's sovereignty

He recognized that everything he had was from God... ...therefore, even in loss, he chose to give thanks



Paul:

- Despite being Imprisoned, Beaten, Shipwrecked, and Facing Numerous Other Hardships for the Sake of the Gospel,
- Paul's Letters are Filled with Expressions of Thankfulness.

"I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, / I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any / every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want." -Phil 4:11-12

 Paul's Thankfulness was Not Tied to His Physical Condition or Circumstances, but to his Contentment in Christ.



- 1 Thes 5:18 "give thanks" -Greek= "eucharisteo"
- This word is used in other passages in the New Testament.
- Jesus uses this word when He breaks the bread at Last Supper

"And he took bread, gave thanks (eucharisteo) and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me.'" -Luke 22:19

Jesus is giving thanks for the bread that...
...symbolizes His body which will be broken for us

- Paul recounts the Last Supper, "and when he had given thanks (eucharisteo), he broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." 1 Corinthians 11:24
- Paul is emphasizing the act of giving thanks as a central part of the Christian practice of communion.



- "eucharisteo" is used in a context of sacrifice and self-giving love.
 - Gives a deeper understanding of what it means to...
 ...give thanks in all circumstances".
 - It is not a superficial but a deep, sacrificial thankfulness ...
 ...recognizes God's love and provision even...
 ...in the midst of hardship / suffering.

In the Life of Jesus:

- We see the ultimate example of thankfulness.
- In Gethsemane, facing the imminent pain / humiliation
- Jesus prayed, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done" -Luke 22:42
 - Jesus' thankfulness was not based on His circumstances, but on His submission to the Father's will.
