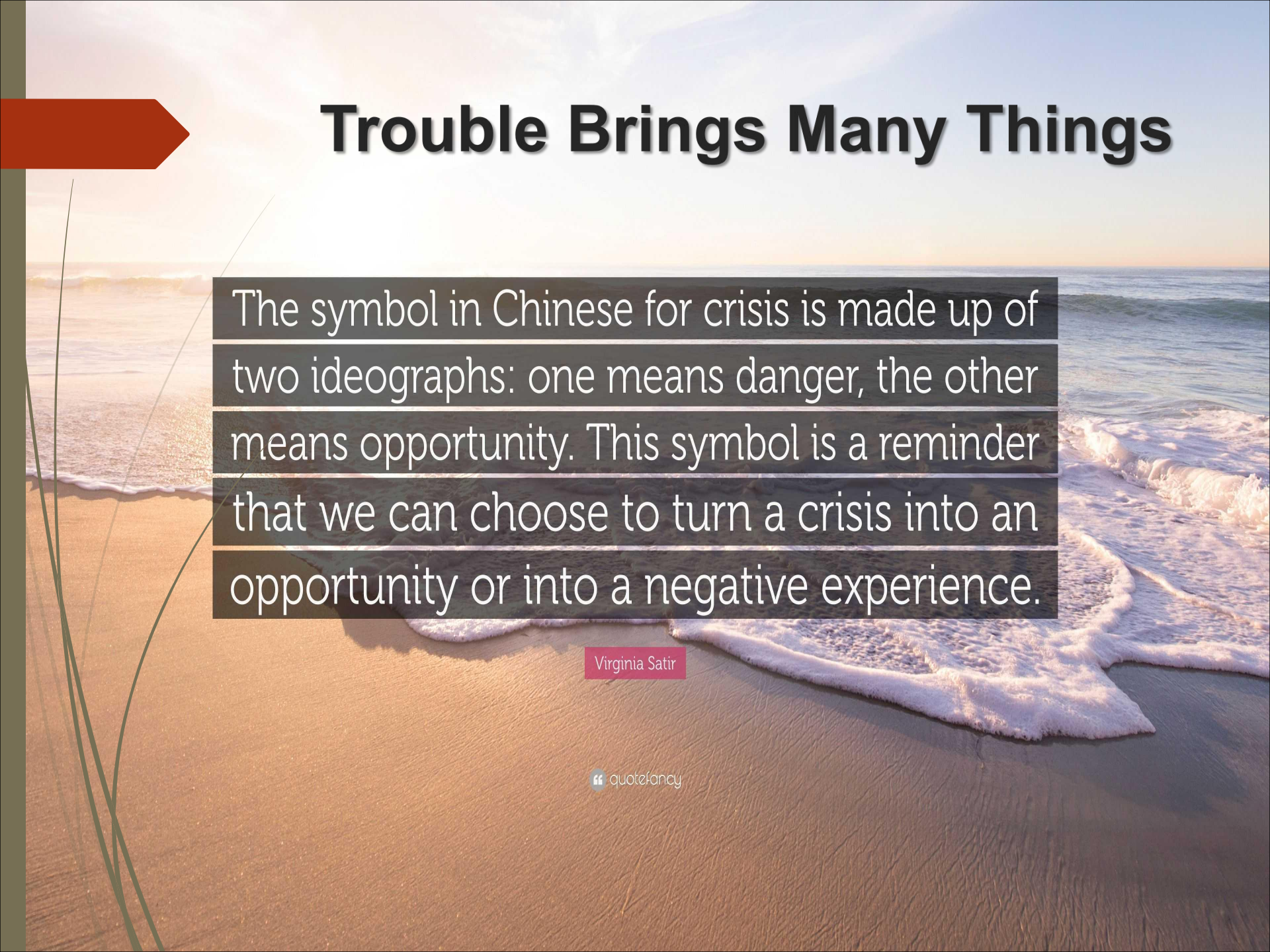

A Thanksgiving Cookbook
