

"We made a decision to turn our will / lives over..."



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



Step 11: Conscious Contact with God


"God Not Only Commutes Your Sentence He Wants to Communicate With You."

Recovery is Not Just Breaking Chains


- It's Building a Relationship.
- God Wants More Than Parole...


 He Wants Presence.

The Heart of Step 11 is Intimacy.

- God Doesn't Just Want to Fix Us
 - He Wants to Walk with us.
 - He Wants us to Hear His Voice,
 Feel His Presence,
 and Live in His Love.









Call to Prayer and Meditation

Step 11 says we sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God.

- Prayer is Us Speaking to God.
- Meditation is Us Listening to God.
 - Conscious Contact means...

...Living Aware of His Presence

... In the Everyday Moments of Life


Meditation

Why This Matters for the Whole Church

- This is not just a Recovery Principle
 - it's a Discipleship Principle
 - Without Prayer, We Drift
- Without <u>Meditation</u>, We Miss God's Whisper
 - Without Conscious Contact,
- We Live As If God Is Distant, When He Is Near



Praying Church
Listening Church
Spirit- led Church

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Closing Challenge

- "Step 11 is not about Perfect Prayers....
 ...It's about Daily Connection.
 - This week, I Challenge You:
- Spend 10 minutes each day in Silence before God
 - Pray Not for Your Will, but His
 - Ask for the Power to Carry It Out
 - Like the astronaut's tether, beekeeper...

 God is inviting us to Live in
 ...Conscious Contact with Him, Every Day

He lifted me of the slimy pit, mud and mire;
