Matthew 5:5 (KJV)

"Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth"

Blessed=

- Happy
- Approved

"True Happiness comes from Knowing ... God Approves of Our Actions"

Humility

1st Step to Happiness is Humility Humility is realizing that

- you can't fix everything.
- you don't have all the answers.
- you need God in our life.

Humility is

- Putting God in Charge.
- becoming Totally Dependant on God
- Realizing that He has All the Answers
- Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven"

Repentance

2nd Step to Happiness is Repentance Repentance is realizing that...

...I have a problem in my life that:

- I can't fix.
- God is not pleased with.
- It is hurting my relationship with Him

Repentance is Weeping and Mourning...

...over the Sin in My Life

"Happy are those who mourn; God will comfort them!" Matthew 5:4 (GNB)

...Separate Distinct Classifications of
Christians

They are Eight Qualities every Christian...

...Should Display in their Lives

And as We are Discovering...
...They are Intimately Tying Together

What Meekness is Not!

Meek Does Not Mean:

- weak
- you never gets angry
- you are helpless

How do we know?

Because the Lord said of himself, "I am meek and lowly" –yet:

- He was not weak
- He got angry (clearing the temple)
- He was not helpless.

What Meekness is!

Meek Does Mean:

- Gentle -humble
- Bridling a horse, or taming a wild animal.
- **Meekness** = the process of teaching or training
- It is not that the animal has become "powerless" ...
 - ...but that the power of the animal has been brought
 - ...under the control of the trainer.

Meekness =

- Power under Control
- Teachability

3rd Step to Happiness is Teachability

Four Characteristics of an UN-Teachable Spirit

Do you care about what others have to say...
...Do you feel threatened by differing opinions?

...Quick to state your case

"Don't push your way to the front; don't sweet-talk your way to the top. Put yourself aside, and help others get ahead. Don't be obsessed with getting your own advantage. Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself." Philippians 2:3-5 (MSG)

#2-Repentive Spirit

- Lord I'm sorry for all my "know it all moments"
- Psalms 34:18 (NIV) The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

Characteristics of a Teachable Spirit

#3- A Hunger for Wisdom

 James 1:5 But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all men generously and without reproach, and it [wisdom] will be given to him.

#4- Opened Eyes -Unclogged Ears -Closed Mouth

James 1:19 (AMP)

Understand [this], my beloved brethren. Let every man be quick to hear [a ready listener], slow to speak, slow to take offense and to get angry.

- An open mind and a closed mouth provide an atmosphere conducive for learning.
- "A Closed Mouth Gathers NO Foot"

Characteristics of a Teachable Spirit

#5- A Positive Outlook

1 Pet 2:9 (AMP) But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds /display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

#6- Submitting To Authority and Staying Accountable

 Romans 14:12 - So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

#7- Desperation for God

 Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding
