

Matt 5:10-12, Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteous" sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you,/ shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you

Blessed= Happy

Persecuted=

...Chased After

...Means I'm Still in Front!

Saving the Best for Last



- It's the Last Beatitude /Serves as a Test of All Others
- Persecution is a Normal Mark of Discipleship
- It's the Longest one and it's the Hardest to Embrace
- It's the only One with a Command: "Rejoice / be Glad"
- It's the only One with an Explanation
- It's the only One Repeated Twice
- "Blessed" used Two Times as though Jesus is saying, "You are doubly blessed when you are persecuted"
- It's the Only Beatitude Addressed Directly to Us



Persecution

Persecution is...

- Chased after- to Pursue
- Trouble -Harassment
- Pressed Tight Place
- Drive Away

Categories

- Test of Character-"Verbal Insults"
- Insult =to chide, taunt, or defame.
- Luke 6:22: "Blessed are you when men hate you, when they
- exclude you, and insult you, and reject your name as evil,
- because of the son of man."
- Test of Comfort-"Physical Attack"
- Persecute="to chase away or pursue with hostile intent, to be hunted down as an animal."
- The tense of the verb= "have endured repeated raiding"



Reasons for Persecution

- 1. Because of the Life we Live (10)
- "those who are persecuted because of righteousness"
- 2. Because of the Lord we Love (11)
- Jesus says people will Insult, Persecute, and
- say False Things "because of me"
- This Helps us Define the word "righteous"
- Righteous simply means being like Jesus Christ...
- ...and Doing the Right Thing

Faithfulness and the Apostles

- James was beheaded
- Phillip was scourged, thrown into prison, and then crucified
- Matthew was slain with a sword
- James the Less was stoned to death
- Matthias was stoned and then beheaded
- Andrew was crucified and left hanging on the cross 3 days
- Peter was crucified upside down at his own request
- Jude (Thaddeus) was crucified
- Bartholomew was beaten with clubs and then crucified.
- Thomas was speared to death
- Simon the Zealot was crucified
- John died at 100 of old age in Ephesus







Great Pleasure-"Rejoice, and Be Exceeding Glad" (12)

- Jesus promised them suffering, persecution, and a cross.
- o Rejoice= "be glad, to rejoice exceedingly, to thrive."
- Exceedingly Glad- "to exult, rejoice exceedingly"
- literally..to skip, jump, and leap for joy

Glorious Promise-"Great Is Your Reward in Heaven" (12)

- There are at Least Three Reasons for the Joy of the Christian
- #1- Luke 10:20 "Rejoice, because your names are written in heaven"
- #2- Rejoice in Anticipation of the Reward for Service.
- #3- Rev. 22:4 we shall see the Savior's Face...
- ...when the severity of persecution will fade into insignificance.
- Grand Privilege- We Follow in the Prophets' Footsteps (12)
- o **Hebrews 12:1 (AMP)** ¹ THEREFORE THEN, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who have borne testimony to the Truth], let us strip off *and* throw aside every encumbrance (unnecessary weight) and that sin which so readily (deftly and cleverly) clings to *and* entangles us, and let us run with patient endurance *and* steady *and* active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us





1. Persecution Confirms our Relationship

- We should rejoice that people see Jesus in us.
- o 1 Peter 4:16: "If you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but
- praise God that you bear his name."
- Suffering is the Badge of our Discipleship.

2. Persecution Causes Reliance

- When we suffer we are more Prone to do some Self-examination
- We are Forced to Lean on God in Ways as Never Done Before
- When we do, we See God's Power
- •2 Corinthians 12:9-1"Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong."





3. Persecution Cultivates Righteousness

- Best Way to Grow is to Go Through Some Grief
- 1 Peter 5:10: "And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you /make you strong, firm and steadfast."

4. Persecution Confers a Reward

- Suffering, causes us to focus on what's to come in heaven.
- We can jump for joy because of what's ahead.
- We may lose everything on earth, but...
 - ... we shall inherit everything in heaven.
